19 Pursuant to Ariz. R. Evid. R. 201, Defendant, EWING REDMOND SAMUELS, in propria
20 persona, hereby notifies the Court of incontrovertible material adjudicative facts with
21 ALISA MICHELLE HUDSON CRIMINAL HISTORY & ARREST RECORD. According to the rules
22 of protocol, the Court must take judicial notice of adjudicative facts to correct the record.
23 Defendant is entitled to be heard on the propriety of taking judicial notice and the
24 nature of the fact to be noticed.

This motion is made fully supported by the following memorandum of points and authorities.

MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

01. Long-established Supreme Court precedent holds that the law requires the prosecution to disclose exculpatory and impeachment material, whether or not the defendant requests any such evidence.

02. Brady v. Maryland, 373 U.S. 83, 83 S.Ct. 1199 (1963); Ciglar v. United States, 405 U.S. 150 (1972);

03. United States v. Agurs, 417 U.S. 97, 107, 96 S.Ct. 2382, 44 L.Ed.2d 342 (1974); Stickler v. Greene, 527 U.S.

04. 263, 280, 119 S.Ct. 1936, 144 L.Ed.2d 286 (1999)

05. At trial, the prosecution remarked, "we don't disclose." (cc 1/25/17, pp. 26)

06. The record is the proof — the State of Arizona knowingly engaged in a complete and total disregard of the rule of law and willfully violated Defendant's fundamental constitutional rights with the fraudulent concealment of material impeachment and exculpatory evidence of witness, Alisha Michelle Hudson. The prosecution's suppression of criminal history, arrest record, police reports, erratic nature, volatile behavior, substance abuse issues, and domestic violence problems was intentional — and therefore, nondisclosure was definitely by design. This motion includes indisputable material facts that proves the State's abuse of process and the trial court's approval reveals an abuse of discretion to make findings on an unconstitutionally incomplete record.

07. Fraudulent concealment, according to Black's Law Dictionary is "the affirmative suppression or hiding, with the intent to deceive or defraud, of a material fact or circumstance that one is legally (or, sometimes morally) bound to reveal."

5 Significance: While her husband and children were asleep, Alisa contacted and then met up

7 Camry and picked up another man at a McDowell address. "They drove to the west of south
8 mountain park." They were all drinking beer and smoking marijuana. According to her, she was
9 then sexually assaulted. Alisa's husband, Nicholas Curd told officers, she sometimes does
10 "strange things" when she is under the influence of alcohol. "Alisa then told me that she and
11 ... had been having a sexual relationship. I asked Alisa what she wanted to do about this
12 matter and she told me that she did not really want to do anything, but that her husband was
13 insistent. This report will be unfounded as the elements of the crime of sexual assault
14 are not present. Alisa had voluntarily had sexual intercourse with the men..."

22 that they have recently been separated and are seeking a divorce. A witness, Julie, the

manager of the apartment complex said Alisa continued yelling obscenities at Nicholas while following him around. She also advised that SP2 Alisa would hit SP1 Nicholas at a rate of ten punches to SP1 Nicholas' one punch. She said it appeared to be a mutual combat situation however, SP2 Alisa was definitely instigating the fight. "Due to the fact that SP1 Nicholas had two small children to care for because SP2 Alisa was baby-sitting several small children, I felt it was in the best interest of the Phoenix Police Department that neither of them be arrested this evening. I advised both parties to seek an order of protection. I request that this report be reviewed for charging SP1 Nicholas and SP2 Alisa with mutual assault, domestic violence, on each other." P1 Alisa stated that she does not have any money and is going bankrupt. I was not able to contact SP1 Jamil at this time because he was not there. P1 Alisa stated that her son, SP1 Jamil admitted to throwing the rock and hitting the car window. I advised the victim since the suspect was only seven years old it would not be possible to charge the listed suspect with a criminal offense. 23 by SPT Lynn Boyd. V8 Alisa Boyd then stated that after officers left earlier that
24 night at approximately 0215 hrs, SPT Lynn Boyd then returned back to the residence
25 and called approximately nine times. SPT Lynn Boyd then used his personal key to

enter the residence, as VI Alisa Boyd stated that she was trying to hold the door shut. The next thing she knew, SPl Lynn Boyd was inside the house. VI Alisa Boyd did not have any visible injuries on her face where she claimed she was hit... I noticed that there were no signs of anything broken as if someone had been wrestling inside the house. Officer Brooks 9418 and I were at this residence earlier that night in reference to a family fight. It turned out that Officer Brooks and I had served a restraining order on SPl Lynn Boyd on 040110, at approximately 0206 hrs, by Officer Brooks 9418... 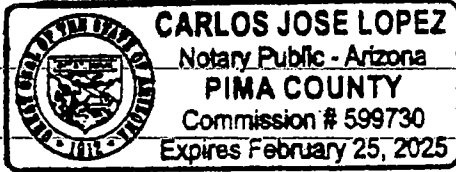



SHE ADVISED ME THAT THEY HAVE RECENTLY BEEN SEPARATED AND ARE SEEKING A DIVORCE.

SHE SAID THAT AT ONE POINT SP1 NICHOLAS THREW HER UP AGAINST THE WALL ON

I CONTACTED SP1 NICHOLAS OUTSIDE OF HIS APARTMENT AND HE TOLD ME THE FOLLOWING:

SP1 NICHOLAS SAID THAT HE AND HIS WIFE, SP2 ALICA, HAD RECENTLY BEEN SEPARATED AND THEY ARE SEEKING A DIVORCE. HE SAID THAT SP2 ALICA ARRIVED THIS EVENING AND DROPPED OFF THEIR TWO KIDS. I ADVISED BOTH PARTIES TO SEEK AN ORDER OF PROTECTION. I REQUEST THAT THIS REPORT BE REVIEWED FOR CHARGING SP1 NICHOLAS AND SP2 ALICA WITH MUTUAL ASSAULT, DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, ON EACH OTHER.

BOTH SUBJECTS WILL AID IN PROSECUTION.

ON 04/06/10, I REVIEWED THIS REPORT. I CALLED THE SUSPECT, LYNN BOYD, AND SPOKE TO HIM ABOUT THIS REPORT. THIS INTERVIEW WAS DIGITALLY RECORDED, AND THE RECORDING WAS LATER FORWARDED TO THE FORENSIC IMAGING UNIT FOR STORAGE.

LYNN PROVIDED HIS BIRTHDATE, TO VERIFY HIS IDENTITY. I EXPLAINED I WAS INVESTIGATING A REPORT OF A VIOLATION OF AN ORDER OF PROTECTION ON 04/01/10. LYNN TOLD ME HE KNEW EXACTLY WHAT I WAS TALKING ABOUT, AND EXPLAINED THAT MORNING HE WAS SERVED AN ORDER OF PROTECTION. LYNN WAS GIVEN A RIDE BY POLICE TO A FRIENDS HOUSE NEARBY, AND ABOUT AN HOUR LATER, LYNN HAD HIS FRIEND TONY, DRIVE TO THE HOUSE AND PICK UP HIS VEHICLE WHICH WAS LEFT AT THE HOUSE. LYNN EXPLAINED THE REASON HE DID NOT TAKE THE VEHICLE EARLIER WHEN HE WAS SERVED, WAS BECAUSE HE HAD BEEN DRINKING ABOUT 5 HOURS EARLIER, AND THE OFFICERS TOLD HIM HE PROBABLY SHOULD NOT BE DRIVING.
